## Fellows Spotlight: Meet Three Fellows from the Class of 2021

**Robert E. Sevila** is a partner at Sevila, Saunders, Huddleston and White, PC in Leesburg with a focus on real estate, land use, and commercial law. Under his leadership as mayor of the town of Leesburg, Robert saw the town expand and double in size during his tenure from 1982 through 1992. He has served on the board of the Loudoun County Chamber of Commerce since 1991 and teaches Business Law as an adjunct professor at Shenandoah University. He is also a founding member of the George C. Marshall International Center, which preserves the legacy of the Nobel Peace Prize laureate and master architect of the Marshall Plan in post-war Europe.



He has been very active in the Loudoun County Bar Association, serving on the Bylaws and Domestic Relations committees and as president. In 2005, the governor named him to the Commonwealth Transportation Board, and he received the General Practice Tradition of Excellence Award from the General Practice Section of the Virginia State Bar in 2004.



**The Honorable Kathleen M. Uston** serves on the Alexandria Circuit Court and is an adjunct professor of law at American University Washington College of Law where she teaches Litigation Ethics. She received her J.D. from George Mason University School of Law in 1991 where she served as President of the Student Bar Association and as a Justice on the Moot Court Board. Kathleen was previously in private practice doing ethical defense, GAL work, and civil litigation. While in private practice, she also served as a Commissioner in Chancery for the Circuit Court for the City of Alexandria.

A past President of the VSB Young Lawyers Conference, she served on the VSB Council and Executive Committee.

Kathleen also served as vice-chair of the American Bar Association Young Lawyers Division Solo and Small Firm Committee. Currently, she is President of the Alexandria Bar Association and a member of the Board of Directors of the National Organization of Bar Counsel. Kathleen has lectured extensively on the subject of attorney ethics and co-authored the updated edition of *Lawyers and Other People's Money* with Frank Thomas. She also serves on three committees on Lawyer Wellness: the National Task Force on Lawyer Well-Being, the Virginia Supreme Court's Committee and the VSB's Presidential Task Force on Lawyer Wellness. Kathleen is co-chair of the Alexandria Bar Association's Jazz4Justice Committee.

**The Honorable Robert W. Wooldridge** is a retired judge who served at the Fairfax County Circuit Court from 1992 through 2008. He has also been a member of the board of directors for the Legal Services of Northern Virginia and the Medical Care for Children Project. Judge Wooldridge was a professor at the George Mason Law School from 2000 through 2012 and membership chairman of the Young Lawyers Section of the Virginia Bar Association. He also served on the Bar Council and Tenth District Grievance Committee of the Virginia State Bar.

## Fellows in Memoriam

**Honoring the Legacies of George Hettrick Harrison (Fellows Class of 1998) and Governor A. Linwood Holton, Jr. (Fellows Class of 1987)**



**George Harrison Hettrick** (Fellows Class of 1998) passed away on Wednesday, November 24, 2021, at the age of 81.

A US Army veteran who served our country in Germany in the late 1960s, Mr. Hettrick received his undergraduate degree from Cornell University and his J.D. from Harvard Law School. Throughout his career in the legal field, he placed emphasis on pro bono engagement, and for the last 30 years before retiring in 2018, Mr. Hettrick served as the chair of Hunton & Williams' pro bono committee. While fostering a deep commitment to pro bono service,

Mr. Hettrick helped the firm achieve 100 percent participation in pro bono projects, open two pro bono offices in Richmond and Charlottesville, and create pro bono fellowships for young attorneys interested in pursuing a career in public service.

The Harvard law graduate was a loyal friend to the Virginia Law Foundation for decades and a member of the Fellows Class of 1987.
